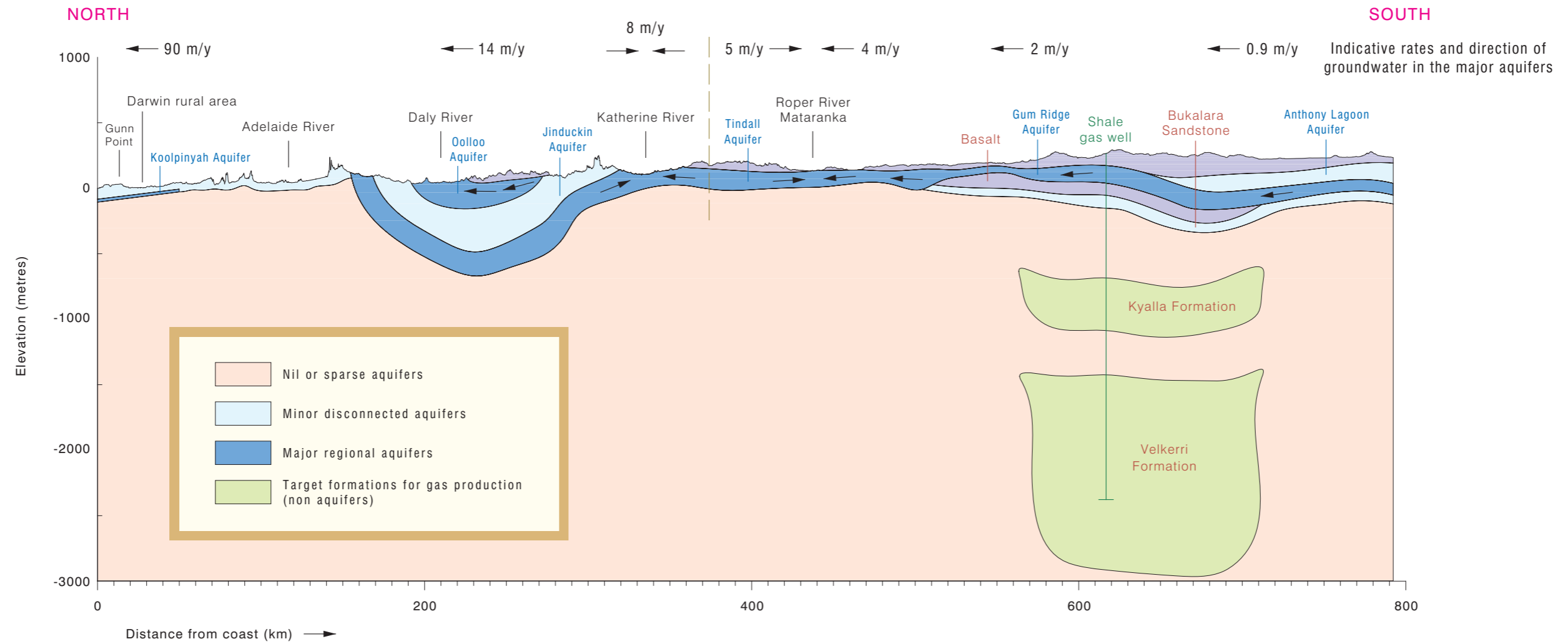
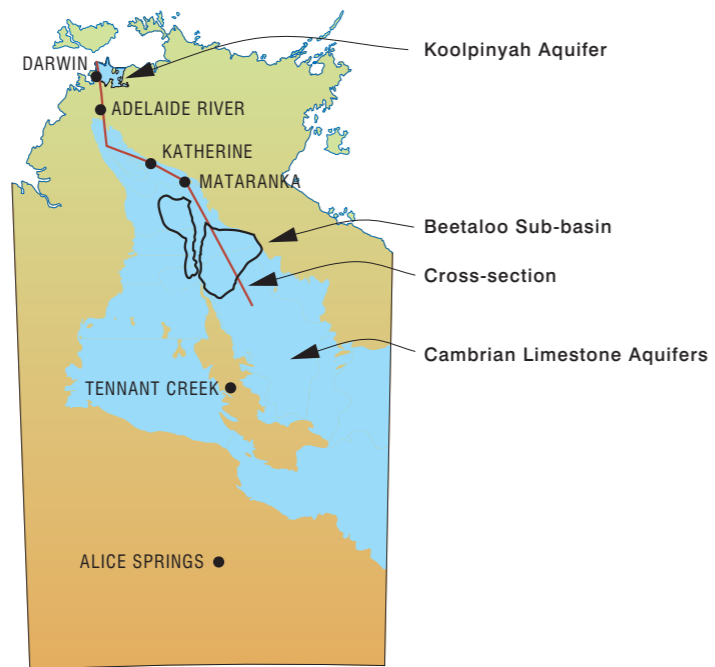


# MAJOR AQUIFERS FROM GUNN POINT TO THE BEETALOO SUB-BASIN



## NORTHERN TERRITORY



This cross-section aims to illustrate the extent and depths of major aquifers in relation to the gas-producing formations in the Beetaloo Sub-basin.

Various important aquifers are shown on the cross-section. The Oolloo, Jinduckin, Tindall, Anthony Lagoon, and Gum Ridge Aquifers are collectively referred to as the Cambrian Limestone Aquifers (CLA). The Koolpinyah, Oolloo, Tindall and Gum Ridge are major aquifers that are capable of supporting irrigation developments. The Jinduckin and Anthony Lagoon Aquifers are minor aquifers more suitable for stock and domestic purposes. The Bukalara Sandstone is also shown but little is known about its properties.
